Why cook together?

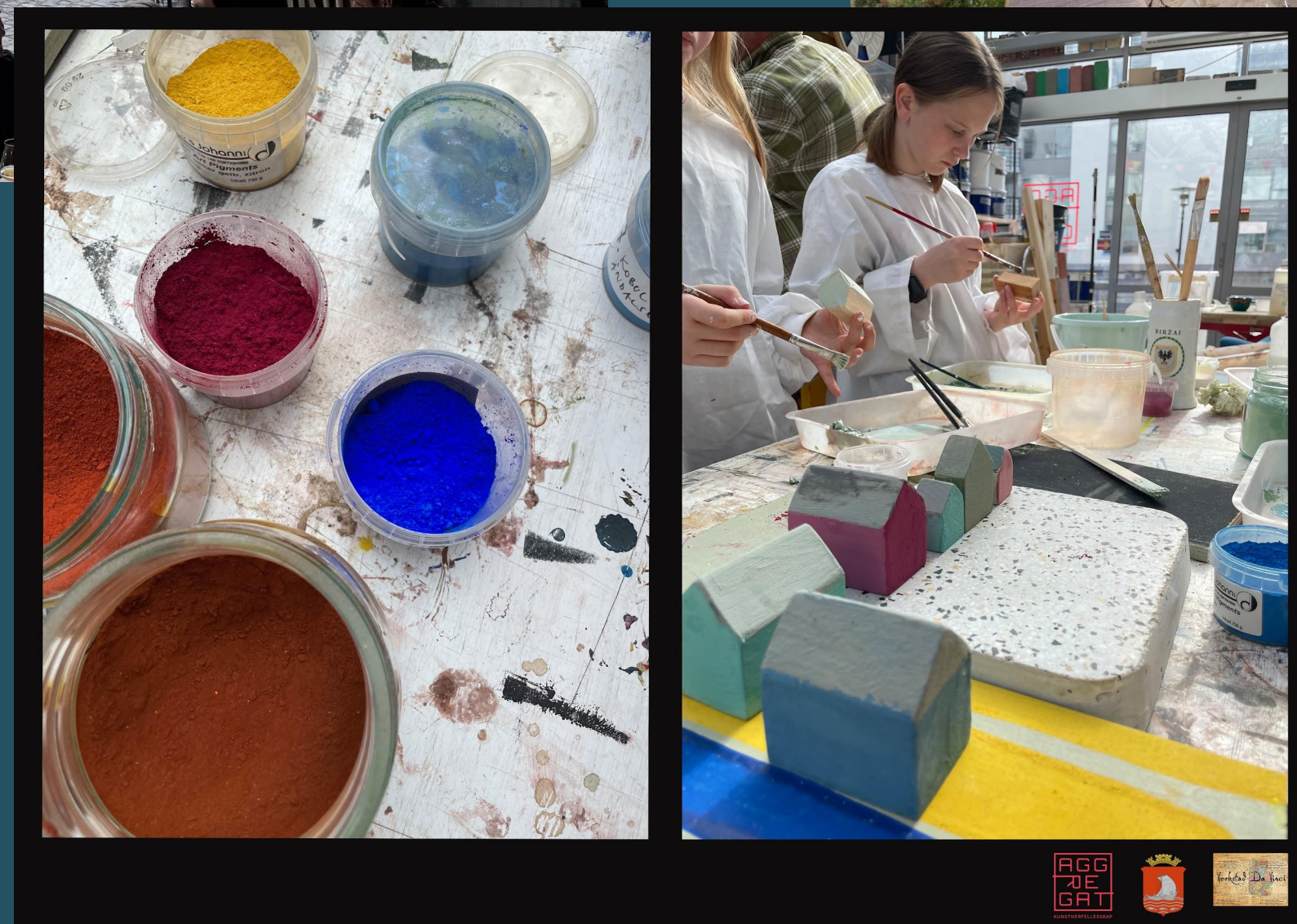
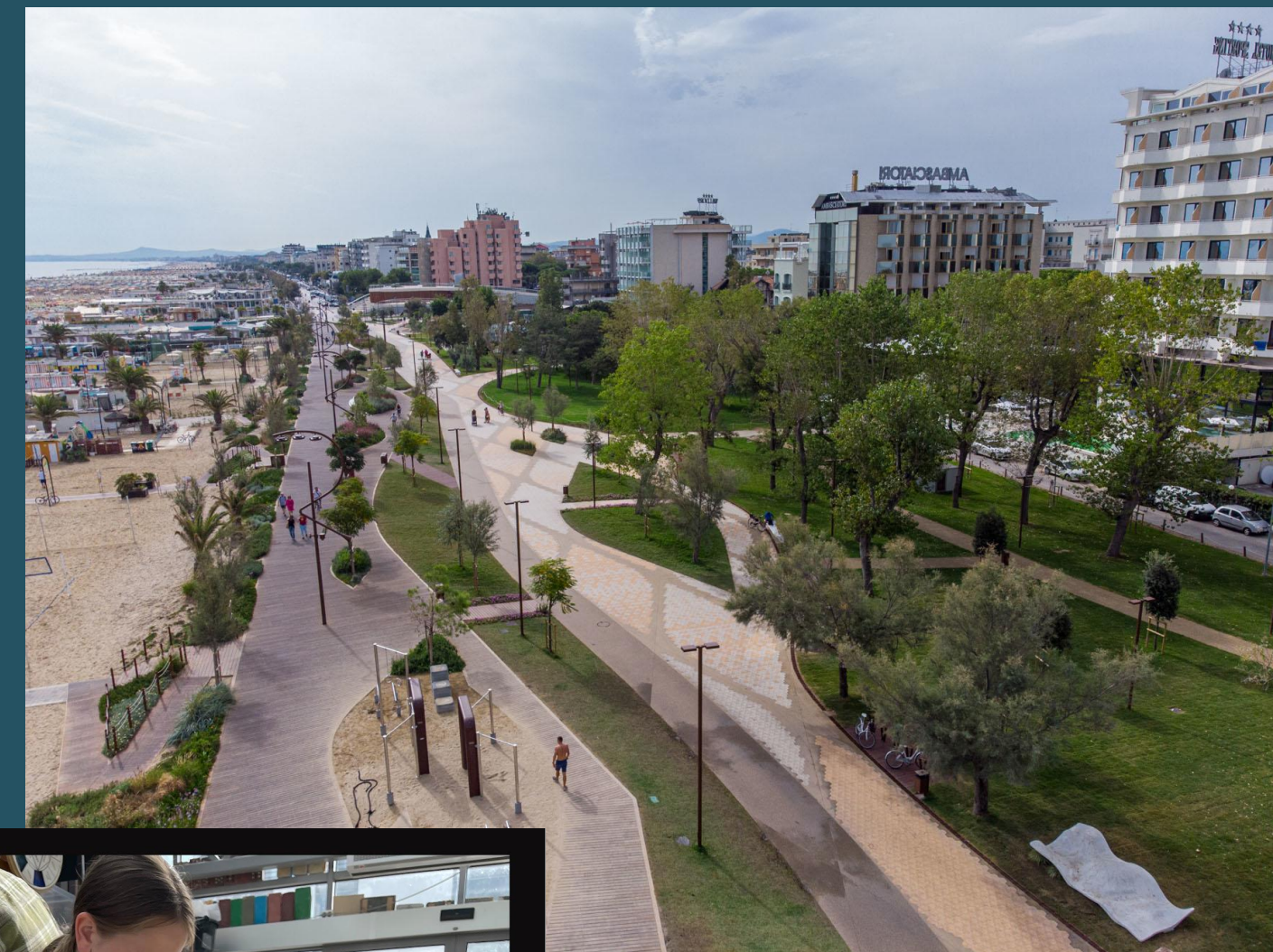
- You can see how others approach comparable challenges

How did we work on the cookbook?

- We used the Climate-neutral and Smart City Guidance Package (2019) as a basis
- We organised 9 engaging CrAft Cities Sessions from January to March
- We collected a wealth of good examples from our 63 CrAft cities
- We started X-rays in selected cities to discover where CrAft info can make most impact in policy and decision making
- We organised ourselves : harvesters, writers, editors

Second edition:

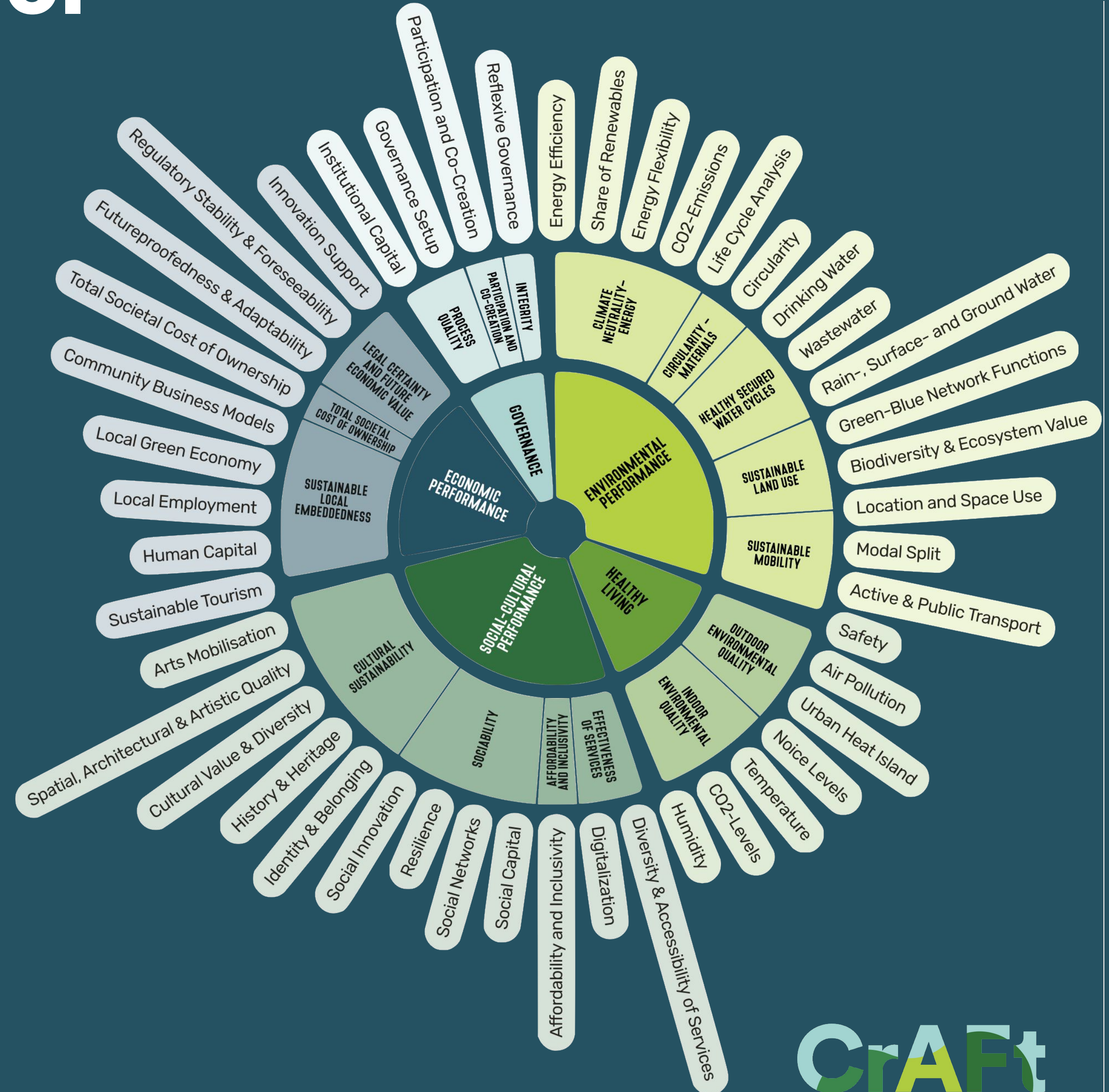
- Broaden to specific groups and identify/specify roles & needs

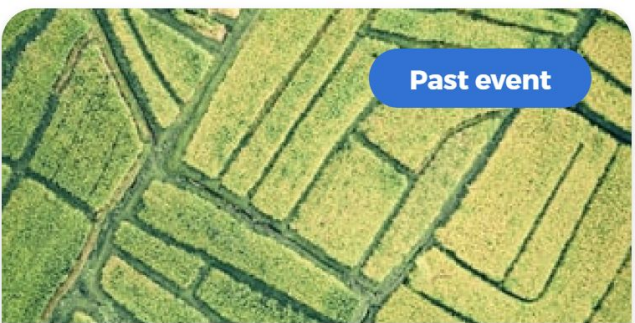

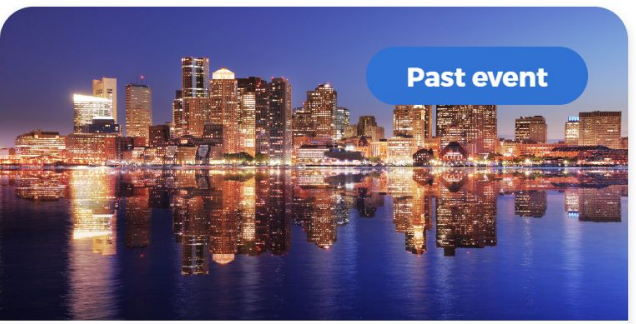

Public officers and Practitioner Community

The Co-funded European Partnership Driving Urban Transitions covers activities to strengthen capacity building, international cooperation and policy relations. The urban challenge is primarily characterised by the need for integrated approaches and to translate research and innovation results to urban applications. The DUT Partnership steps up the game to tackle urban challenges and Public Officers and Practitioners Community (PoP C) enables local authorities and municipalities to promote global strategies into local action.

POPC WORKS ON GAPS!

The relationship between research and practitioner endeavour is not easy and straightforward - it needs deliberative attention from both researchers and practitioners to deliver. There is a range of barriers to effective exchange and knowledge transfer in research and practitioner contexts. Some are general to broader social policy systems and others are more particularly associated with urban planning. These four community will construct four types of gaps:

<p>Organisational Focus on the organisational dimension among offices and departments to avoid silo effect.</p>	<p>Procedures and instruments Focus on procedures and instruments aspects which support transformation processes related to the selected projects.</p>
<p>Finance Focus on investment, funding and business models which support transformation processes related to the selected projects.</p>	<p>Technology Focus on existing technological solutions to support transition.</p>

The DUT Partnership in a nutshell



- A public-public partnership, co-funded by 28 European countries and the European Commission
- Intergovernmental research and innovation programme for sustainable, inclusive, climate-neutral urban areas
- Annual calls addressing topics related to three Transition Pathways
 - Positive Energy Districts and Neighbourhoods transforming the urban energy system
 - Circular Urban Economies for an integrated approach for urban greening and circularity transitions
 - 15-minute Cities rethinking the urban mobility system and space
- 450 million EURO minimum indicative budget for 2022-2028
- Comprehensive programme management to create and facilitate a European innovation eco-system on urban matters
- R&I funding instruments that allow full participation of city administration, municipalities, local initiatives, etc. in projects (watch out for the Urban Doers Grant and our annual calls)
